The Influence of Teaching Games for Understanding on Students' Football Skills Training Results by Joko Purwanto, Dimyati, Ermawan Susanto

ABSTRACT

Previous studies have focused more on various characteristics of sports participation. This research examines children's experiences of football using quantitative methods. This research specifically explores: What does it mean for children (N=116) aged 6 – 9 years who participate in football schools in Yogyakarta? Research data was obtained using the FUN-MAPS instrument (Visek et al., 2015) which was given to respondents (N=116) using the online method. The results showed that the level of enjoyment of children practicing soccer was 12% very high, 10% high, 58% medium, 15% low, and 5% very low. The research findings support conclusions in previous literature about what constitutes enjoyment for young athletes, and also increase understanding of other aspects of children's experiences specifically in football.
