## ANALYSIS OF CHALLENGES STUDENTS STUDY PROGRAM INDONESIA FACULTY OF LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE ARTS UNY RESEARCH IN ANTROPOLINGUISTIK

## **ABSTRACT**

Objectives to be achieved in this study is to describe the obstacles and constraints factors causing students of Indonesian Literature Faculty of Language and Art UNY in research antropolinguistik.

The research design used in this study is a survey research. The study population is all students Literary Studies Program Indonesia FBS UNY while samples in this study are students of Indonesian Literature Faculty of Language and Art UNY force in 2013 which numbered 70 people. The instrument used in this study was a questionnaire. The research data were collected and analyzed with descriptive analysis. Furthermore, the conclusion.

The results of this study are as follows. First, there are several obstacles students of Indonesian Literature in research antropolinguistik. These constraints, which is associated with widespread understanding antropolinguistik study, the use of various techniques of data collection, transcription of data, and a description of the results of studies using punctuation, spelling, and sentence appropriate. Second, the cause of the constraints faced by the students in research antropolinguistik due to several things. In the case of widespread understanding antropolinguistik study, students find obstacles because many students who live in areas surrounding already modern society that values ??or cultural activities is not there anymore. In addition, they have also been less concerned with the people around them and they have not read many books, articles, related research antropolinguistik. Further constraints on the use of various techniques of data collection. Some students simply use interviewing techniques just because at least the source of the research topic of their choosing. In terms of data transcription obstacles encountered due to the limitations of students in mastering the local language used informants and boredom when they do the transcription of data. Lastly in terms describe the results of their research into written form with punctuation, spelling, and proper punctuation. Presumably what has been given by the Indonesian lecturers / writing scientific papers not settle in their minds. They have not been fully informed about the use of spelling, proper punctuation and how to write effective sentence appropriate.
