ABSTRACT

Learning during the pandemic forces parents to have skills in using technology. Through the use of digital technology, parents of students get various conveniences in obtaining teaching materials. Students can carry out learning at the same time using groups on social media such as the Zoom application, Google Classroom, or the Quizizz application as a medium for student evaluation learning. Several housewives in Gumblegan village, who mostly accompany children to study at the elementary school level, show that they do not have the skills to take advantage of the learning features implemented in schools.
