

THE COMMERCIALIZATION PATTERN OF THE FUNCTION OF THE SPATIAL OF DALEM IN THE JERON BETENG AREA OF KRATON YOGYAKARTA Case Study of Dalem Joyokusuman

ABSTRACT

This study aims to analyze the shape and change of living space layout and development pattern of Dalem in Jeron Beteng Kraton Yogyakarta area in the context of change from residential house to commercial building with the case study of Dalem Joyokusuman.

Types of research is qualitative with descriptive methods. Data collection was done through literature study, interviews, observations, and document source observations. The results of the data were analyzed critically to find the conclusions of the study.

Overall, the spatial change in Dalem Joyokusuman is influenced by functional thinking, as evidenced by the increased space available for public and commercial / business activities. The concept of intangible value in the Dalem building that was initially applied has been increasingly eroded by the existence of new functions, but despite the functional changes, in general there is no major structural change of the Dalem building, so the original form is retained . There is no change in the structure of the building (main wall) except the addition of doors to facilitate the circulation of visitors, although this is less appropriate because it precisely removes the sacred core from the traditional building that is Senthong middle.
