

Quality of Coach's Behavior in Efforts to Build and Develop Character Sportsmanship Athlete (Study of Situation Analysis on Football School Coaches Who Trained Young Players in the DIY Province Region)

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ABSTRACT

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Abstract

Unfavorable conditions often afflict football development in Indonesia, ranging from management and organizational management, inadequate infrastructure, riots between players and coaches to between supporters, referee performance, and so on. One of these conditions is influenced by the character of human sportsmanship, both coaches and players who are less educated or nurtured. The purpose of this study was to determine how the behavior of soccer school coaches (SSB) in an effort to foster and develop sportsmanship characters in young athletes.

The design of this research is descriptive quantitative research using survey method. The instrument used to collect research data is in the form of a questionnaire. The sample used in this study were SSB coaches who trained young players, especially between the ages of 13-17 years, totaling 21 coach's from 4 districts and 1 municipality who were taken randomly. The data analysis technique uses descriptive quantitative statistical analysis using the benchmark score assessment criteria (PAP) which will then be presented as a percentage.

The results showed that the overall behavioral quality of football school coaches (SSB) who coached young players (13-17 years) in DIY Province in an effort to foster and develop sportsmanship characters with an average score of 67.00 % and in detail were at category "very high" as many as 0 coach's (0.0 %), "high" as many as 0 coach's (0.0 %), "quite high" as many as 2 coach's (9.53%), "medium" as many as 19 t coach's (90.47 %), "low" as many as 0 coach's (0.0 %) and "very low" as many as 0 coach's (0.0 %).
