Training on the Use of Google Sites to Develop Online Guidance and Counseling Service Media by Agus Triyanto, Ismarini Bekti Setiani, Widya Juwita Sari

ABSTRACT

The PKM DLK (Lecturers with Off-Campus Activities) program conducted an activity titled "Training on the Use of Google Sites to Develop Online Guidance and Counseling Service Media." This activity provided training for high school-level guidance and counseling teachers in the Special Region of Yogyakarta Province, focusing on the development of media-based guidance and counseling services using Google Sites. The objectives of this activity were as follows: 1) To provide training for high school guidance and counseling teachers in utilizing Google Sites for the development of online guidance and counseling services. 2) To enhance the ease and effectiveness of guidance and counseling services in schools.

The training activities utilized independent assignment techniques, commencing with seminars and discussions on online media, Google Sites, and media development practices. The assessment scale for understanding the use of online media and Google Sites was employed as a measuring tool in both the pre-test and post-test stages to determine the effectiveness of this technique. The results of the activity implementation indicated an improvement, as evident from the average pre-test score of 56, which increased to an average post-test score of 70. Based on these results, it can be concluded that this community service activity successfully achieved its objectives.
