

EXPLORATION OF WORK VALUES AND CAREER MOTIVATION IN PREPARING FOR PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCY OF MENTORING AND CONSELING STUDENTS

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ABSTRACT

The study of work values and career motivation is carried out on the basis of a theoretical framework which states that the values contained in individuals determine the direction of career choices, job satisfaction, attitudes, behavior, and social experience of the individual concerned. Explorative research with the main subject of student guidance and counseling is aimed at; 1) explore the types of work values of student guidance and counseling and the relationship patterns between work values, 2) describe career motivation in student guidance and counseling, and 3) predict the influence of work values on student career motivation for guidance and counseling

This research approach uses a cross-sectional and explanatory survey design as well. The research subjects were determined by stratified proportional random sampling from a population of guidance and counseling students of 400 active students. From the data to be collected using an inventory of work values and career motivation, the data analysis technique that will be used is quantitative descriptive with the help of inferential statistical analysis.
