Bugel Village is a strategic area for the development of a new tourist destination area located in Kapanewon Panjatan, Kulon Progo Regency. With its strategic location, it is necessary to add to its attractiveness in terms of tourist attractions. Considering that the area already has a beautiful Bugel beach panorama, as well as a strategic location on the east side of the New Yogyakarta International Airport (NYIA), Kulon Progo. Based on the results of a survey in the area through the cultural assistant of Kapanewon Panjatan, it is said that the current potential has not been exploited in its packaging, so it seems that they are living separately. The potential that already exists in Bugel village is the art of Gejog Lesung and Jathilan independently (alone). These two types of art have never been combined in one concept of presenting a complete harmony. With the PPM program for the FBS UNY group, we will make packaging for the Gejog Lesung jathilan show by utilizing existing natural resources in the form of water hyacinth leaves as raw materials for horse props, costumes and other knick-knacks. Given that the majority of the people in Bugel village are farmers, they prefer instruments that are owned and in accordance with their livelihoods as farmers, namely Gejog Lesung. In addition to the traditional music, the people of Bugel village also like and are able to dance horse braids or jathilan, so they also want the packaging of jathilan performances combined with Gejog Lesung music as a feature of Bugel village.
