TRAINING OF PRODUCTIVE SKILLS TO MAKE TIE DYE TO INCREASE FAMILY INCOME FOR PKK AT SUMBERSARI VILLAGE, MOYUDAN, SLEMAN YOGYAKARTA

ABSTRACT

This Community Service (PPM) activity aims to provide training in productive skills on making tie-dye to PKK women in Sumbersari Moyudan Village, Sleman Yogyakarta. This training is also intended to increase family income for PKK women in Sumbersari Village, Moyudan, Sleman, Yogyakarta The PPM activity methods used are lectures, demonstrations, practice, and mentoring. The material for this activity includes: (1) The theory of tie-dye, various types of tie-dye, tools and materials needed, how to manufacture products using the tie-dye technique, and calculation of sales as entrepreneurial provisions; (2) The practice of making tie-dye products from the preparation of tools and materials, product manufacturing processes, packaging to sales calculations as provisions for entrepreneurship; and (3) Evaluation of the results of making tie-dye for PKK women. This PPM activity was held on May 1-2, 2021, attended by 20 participants with the following activity results: (1) the participants were very enthusiastic to take part in the training on productive productive skills of making tie-dye as evidenced by the enthusiasm for learning, attendance, and sincerity in completing tasks assigned by the service team; (2) the target of the training can be achieved well, it can be proven from all participants (100%) able to complete the manufacture of tie-dye in the form of uniform fabric which can be of economic value.
