Women Empowerment Program though Training of Producing Accessories Utilizing Batik Waste in Kwagon Village

ABSTRACT

This community service program aims to train women in Kwagon Vilage in producing accessories using batik waste as the main material. Knowledge and motivation of entrepreneurships was also be emphasized in this program. Therefore, women in Kwagon Vilage have an alternative to create a business. Twelve women joint in this training as active participant. This program has been held on May 12th, 2018 in Kwagon Village.

This community service program has already held successfully based on three indicators: 1) was attended by 12 women (the target is 20-25 women, or about 60% attendance); 2) all participant follow the training from biginning until the end of training; and there is participant that has intention to create a small business utilizing her knowledge that they got from this women empowerment program.
