BANDUNG FUN FAIR CHARITY: EFFORTS TO HELP THE LIFE OF THE INDONESIAN INVALIDENT UNIT (PII), 1949-1950

ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine the role of the Charity Night Market for Indonesian Invalide Perstuan (PII). Soldiers who were physically disabled due to Military Aggression II would have experienced difficulties in living after Indonesian sovereignty was recognized by the Dutch on 27 December 1949. Amal Night Market was one of the activities aimed at helping PII. The problems that arose from the topic raised included the activities of how to carry out charity night market activities in 1949 and 1950 in an effort to assist PII; how the efforts of the night market committee in attracting public interest, and how the impact of holding a charity fair. The research method used is the historical method. This method includes four steps. First, heuristic or looking for sources related to research. Second, verification or source criticism which includes external criticism and internal criticism. Third, interpretation or interpreting existing historical facts. Finally, historiography or history writing.
