

SOCIAL NETWORK ADAPTATION AND NETWORK IN BUILDING RESILIENCE OF FAMILY RECEIVERS OF HOPE FAMILY PROGRAMS (PKH) IN YOGYAKARTA

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ABSTRACT

Despite being a participant in the Family Hope Program (PKH) which the government helped financially and was supported by skills training for productive ventures, they continued to experience problems and challenges. This study discusses how marginal families living in dense settlements and along riverbanks adapt and form social networks for the occurrence of family security. This research was conducted from April to September 2019 using a qualitative approach. Data collection techniques such as observation, in-depth interviews. Data analysis is done through data reduction, presentation and conclusion drawing. The study of adaptation and social networking to build family resilience involved 45 families as the unit of analysis. The results of this study reveal that marginal families as participants of the hope program formed by the Indonesian government have the ability to adapt and use social networking when various economic, social and educational problems of children suffer from it. With various forms of adaptation and variety of social networks to build family resilience. Social adaptation, such as *Involvement*, *Believe*, *Commitment* and increasing *Attachment* for their children are also developed as social capital in their marginal conditions
