The data analysis techniques used were discourse analysis, quantitative descriptive, and qualitative descriptive. Discourse analysis was conducted to analyse the content of German literature teaching materials and the results of the reception of German literature. German literature. Quantitative descriptive analysis was used in interpreting findings of the questionnaire and field survey data, especially those related to the understanding of the concretisation and field test of the learning module. learning module. Data validity was achieved by several methods, namely: (1) data data collection methods include observation, interviews, documentation, questionnaires, (2) multiple data sources, including written data, and multiple data sources, including written data, visual data, (3) persistence of observation, (4) discussion between researchers, (4) expert judgement.
