## parent and school partnership at SDIT Jabal Nur

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## **ABSTRACT**

This study aims to explore information related to how schools partner with parents of students at the Jabal Nur SDIT Yogyakarta. The target to be achieved in this study is the discovery of various school efforts in establishing partnerships between schools and parents or guardians of students in the Jabal Nur Yogyakarta SDIT which later can be published in national journals or international journals.

This research is a descriptive study with a qualitative approach. The subjects of the study were principals, teachers, and students at SDIT Jabal Nur Yogyakarta. Data collection techniques used in this study are observation, interviews, and documentation. Data validity checking technique used is method triangulation technique. The analysis technique used in this research is inductive analysis technique, which is analysis that departs from the data and leads to general conclusions. Data analysis steps include: data reduction, unitization and categorization, data display, and conclusion drawing.

The results showed that in an effort to establish partnerships between parents and schools in SDIT Jabal Nur, it was carried out in various forms of academic and non-academic activities. The school has planned activities that involve parents for a school year. These activities are parents and teacher meetings (POMG), parenting school, jabal nur fair, whatsapp group, instagram, facebook, infaq, market day. In its implementation, POMG activities are carried out according to a predetermined schedule. Parenting school activities and Jabal Nur Fair are held once a year which involves all components of the school, whatsapp group is active every day, communication through social media Instagram and Facebook. The social media factor is both supportive and inhibiting in establishing communication between parents and schools. As a supporting factor, social media facilitates communication, while as a barrier, with social media parents rely heavily on information through this media. From various research findings in SDAL Jabal Nur to establish partnerships between parents and schools that still need attention is the implementation of POMG which is still minimal and the absence of a curriculum for parenting school activities according to the needs of parents.
