## Capacity Building Teacher Training for Middle School PPKn on the Procedure Law of the Constitutional Court in the Case of Election Result Dispute in for MGMP PPKn of Junior High School, Kulonprogo

## **ABSTRACT**

The Community Service Program (PPM) aims to: 1) Increase the capacity of junior high school PPKn teachers in Kulonprogo D.I. Yogyakarta concerning the Procedural Law of the Constitutional Court in the Case of Election Results Disputes. 2) Improve the skills of junior high school teachers in D.I. Yogyakarta in disseminating constitutional insights among students in junior high schools in Kulonprogo.

This service activity is carried out in the form of participatory lectures, unstructured discussions and independent studies. The lecture method is used in transferring basic and general concepts about Constitutional Procedure Law, which are followed by structured discussions on several relevant themes.

The results of this service show: 1) The implementation of the PPM has achieved the goal of increasing the capacity of junior secondary school teachers in Kulonprogo D.I. Yogyakarta concerning the Procedural Law of the Constitutional Court in the Case of Election Results Disputes. 2) Likewise with the aim of improving the skills of junior high school teachers in Kulonprogo D.I. Yogyakarta in disseminating constitutional insights among students, this PPM can also be said to be successful, by looking at the results of the evaluation of the Implementation Team after the implementation of this Program. 3) Improving the skills of teacher training participants in constitutional learning in schools is also stimulated and enriched with case analysis methods utilizing online media in independent study sessions. So, the training also provided training participants with experience to utilize online media in learning Citizenship Education, especially on the topic of constitutional awareness.
