Workshop on Student's Research Group in Senior High School

ABSTRACT

"KIR" or Student's Research Group activities have a close relationship in character building. Character means tool for making, to engrave. Well Organized research groups will be able to bring students to manage groups and together while learning to do research and become the formation of a scientific culture at school.

The research idea can come from anywhere, the student's home environment, or the school environment. Research is not something that has to be completely new, but can be a modification and innovation of existing ideas. Development and Guidance of KIR in SMA, whose success depends on the cooperation of several stake holders. These are include stakeholders in the school (principals, teachers), school facilities, teachers, students, and the parents. KIR is important for schools, for teachers, and for students themselves.
