NATIONAL DANCE TRAINING FOR JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL ARTS AND CULTURE TEACHERS IN YOGYAKARTA

ABSTRACT

To improve teachers in national dance lessons, appreciation for national dances in junior high school/high school/vocational high school and art education socialization in junior high school/high school/vocational high school, particularly performance art/dance, is developed through training national dances based on the lecturers' research.

The Community Service by Lecturer Group was performed by the PPM Teamof the Dance Education Department of FBS of UNY in Yogyakarta. It was a national dance training workshop for arts and culture teachers in the Special Region of Yogyakarta on June–September 2020 at Ki Nartosabdo Building of FBS of UNY, Sleman Regency.
