TRAINING FOR DEVELOPING ONLINE LEARNING MODELS FOR TEACHERS OF SMK NEGERI 1 SETEGAN IN THE ERA OF THE COVID 19 PANDEMIC

ABSTRACT

The Covid-19 pandemic that occurred in Indonesia is an epidemic that has a destructive impact that changes and affects various aspects of life. The same thing happened in the world of vocational education in SMK. Various efforts have been made by various countries and various parties to overcome the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic in the field of education, especially learning. Distance learning through the network (online) is a solution proposed by the government. However, there are still many obstacles in learning by implementing the online learning model. These obstacles, among others, relate to the ability of teachers to implement online learning, the readiness to implement online learning during the Covid-19 pandemic, the selection of the right online learning model and in accordance with vocational subjects in Vocational Schools. Therefore, it is necessary to conduct training for SMK teachers in planning and implementing online learning models that are in accordance with the characteristics of the subjects and in accordance with the conditions and situations during the Covid-19 pandemic. The method of activities carried out is training through lectures, discussions, mentoring and assignments. Through this activity, we found that the online learning model that has been used by SMKN 1 Seyegan teachers in the learning process during the Covid-19 pandemic is quite diverse, including the use of google classroom, google meet, zoom, WA groups, youtube channels. , but this is not yet felt optimal results. Teachers are also not familiar with making story boards even though they often make learning videos to support online learning. This training emphasizes the importance of mastering and optimizing the use of google classroom and making story boards that successfully increase the understanding of the trainees
