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## **ABSTRACT**

Thought MANGKUNEGARA IV contained in his work *Serat Tripama*, a script in the form of song *Dhandhanggula*, unbiased advice to the nation how to behave State defense. This study is intended to reap the positive values ??of the story of Ramayana and Mahabharata epics, especially the study of three figures exemplified in *Serat Tripama* 

The study was conducted by using critical historical method, data is collected from a script Serat Tripama, as primary sources, secondary sources used while the works of researchers who reviewed *Serat Tripama* from various viewpoints. The analysis is conducted qualitatively by a semantic approach to understand the messages conveyed in the text.

The results showed Serat Tripama take the example of three characters from the Ramayana and Mahabharata epic story that is Patih Suwanda (Bambang Sumantri).
