

TRADITIONAL SPORTS FESTIVAL MANAGEMENT TRAINING FOR TEACHERS

ABSTRACT

Traditional sports can be applied in various activities at school, especially in the form of competitions between classes. In Junior High School (SMP), traditional games are rarely practiced, both in learning and outside of learning. This is possible because teachers or school officials do not see the benefits of traditional games and also do not understand the management of traditional games. This community service activity seeks to explain how to manage traditional sports competitions in the form of festivals. PkM activities were carried out for 2 days which included training and simulation activities, as well as practical sports festival implementation. The total number of target audiences involved in PkM activities is 277 people, including: Teachers, Students, Learners and School Employees. This PkM activity has produced publications, activity schedules and festival field layout models as a form of planning and implementing traditional sports festivals.
