ABSTRACT

Pesantren are religious-based educational institutions that are popular in Indonesia. From generation to generation, pesantren education plays a very important role, especially in moral education. Unfortunately, the education pattern of pesantren has not been studied much because the pattern of education is considered different from formal education in Indonesia. On the other hand, the output of formal education in Indonesia at this time is of concern because it only focuses on academic cognitive aspects and ignores psychomotor-affective aspects.
