

The phenomenon of physical literacy of parents and activities of elementary school students.

ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine the phenomenon of parents' physical literacy and elementary school students' activities. Parents play an important role in literacy activities, especially for children, because in general parents take a strategic role in the development and education of children. Elementary Education Curriculum includes six aspects of development namely moral and religious values, social - emotional and independence, language skills, cognitive, physical/motor and arts. Elementary school students usually experience very rapid physical growth. In just two months usually height and weight increase rapidly. This can be seen clearly in motor growth, muscle coordination and physical speed showing striking abilities. This allows the child to make a variety of movements that are more flexible which can then be carried out with various basic movement skills. This research method uses qualitative research methods with interviews to find out the relationship between parents' physical literacy and physical motor learning on children's physical activity during the pandemic. The research population was all teachers of Jetisharjo Public Elementary School, Yogyakarta City and parents of Jetisharjo Public Elementary School students. Furthermore, all populations are used for research so that this research is a population study. Data analysis uses the Miles and Hubberman model analysis.
