

THE DEVELOPMENT OF SPORTS BRANCH BRANCHES ACHIEVEMENTS IN THE SPECIAL REGIONS YOGYAKARTA (A Critical Study)

ABSTRACT

Abstract

The purpose of this research is to study the program of DIY pencak silat development, to study the implementation of DIY pesilat training program, to study the role of trainers in improving the performance of DIY pesilat, to study the role of regional board in participating in improving the achievement of DIY Pencak Silat sports, to study the facilities and infrastructure of Pengda IPSI DIY, public and government support for the improvement of DIY pencak silat achievement, and to examine the achievement of Pencak Silat DIY.

This study uses a qualitative paradigm to explore / find a phenomenon, namely the performance of sports system of achievement pencak silat in Yogyakarta Special Region (DIY). Subjects in the study were trainers, athletes (pesilat), administrators, government and community. Data collection was obtained through observation, in-depth interviews, and documentation. The test data validity using test credibility, transferability, dependability, and confirmability.

The result of the research shows that: 1) Pencak Silat sports coaching program in DIY is done through various ways, such as establishing sports club achievement martial arts, organizing PPLD and holding various championships and cooperation with Disdikpora DIY; 2) Planning and implementation of training programs prepared by trainers by involving the fighters; 3) The qualification of the trainer is in accordance with the minimum standard criteria and is well received by the fighter; 4) The performance of inter-field management of IPSI DIY is less synergistic so it can not be done optimally; 5) Infrastructure infrastructure of each area is uneven; 6) Community and government support for improvement of pencak silat achievement in Pengda IPSI DIY; and 7) Achievement of DIY fighters increases in both the match and TGR categories.
