WORKSHOP ON MAPPING OF BASIC COMPETENCE OF BAHASA INDONESIA COURSE IN CURRICULUM 2013 FOR THE TEACHERS OF MTS IN KEBUMEN REGENCY OF CENTRAL JAVA

ABSTRACT

This activity aims to providing opportunities for teachers to understand adequately the changes in the learning paradigm according to the demands of the 2013 Curriculum and provide opportunities for teachers to understand Graduates' Competency Standards, Content Standards, and KI and KD, conduct KD mapping into learning indicators, and concepts and or the principle of learning that applies a disclosure or research based learning mode (discovery / inquiry learning) and learning that produces work based problem solving (project based learning). The method of activity used is training and workshops using the andragogy approach. This method was chosen so that participants could experience each step of the activity process according to the problems and needs they faced at school. This activity can be carried out in accordance with the planned schedule. This activity was attended by 52 Indonesian language teachers. As a result, participants can take part in activities from beginning to end in earnest, both in equating perceptions through lectures and question and answer as well as in the practice of KD mapping, understanding KD stepping steps, conducting KD mapping as a reference for preparing lesson plans. Most of the participants were satisfied with the implementation of this activity and felt they gained the valuable knowledge and skills they needed in conducting KD mapping.
