DEVELOPMENT OF NUSANTARA E-MODULES BASED ON LOCAL WISDOM IN YOGYAKARTA

ABSTRACT

This research focuses on (1) developing the Indonesian archipelago module as material for students in deepening knowledge in the Nusantara module program (2) testing the validity of the module prepared to increase knowledge of diversity. This research is development, including analysis, design, development, implementation and evaluation. Development in the form of an Indonesian e-module based on local wisdom. -Module created by researchers using the flipbook application. The research results showed that the module was developed with material on the history of the city of Yogyakarta, Traditional Event Traditions, Yogyakarta Palace, Yogyakarta Dance, Variety of Yogyakarta Batik Notes, Yogyakarta Typical Culinary and Yogyakarta Historical Sities. The electronic book was developed using "PUBHTML 5" so it is easily accessed via mobile phone. The validity test results show that the E-book has appropriate content, language and presentation. For image accuracy and clarity the terms have moderate validity with a score of 0.6. Meanwhile, for ease of language understanding, it has moderate validity with a score of 0.8. Other items, namely ease of access, layout, correctness and accuracy of the material, have a score of > 0.8. So it can be concluded that based on the validity test the E-module is suitable for use and tested further.
