## CULTURE-BASED EDUCATION IMPLEMENTATION IN JAVA LANGUAGE LESSONS IN SMA BANTUL DISTRICT

## **ABSTRACT**

DIY Regional Government has issued Regional Regulation No. 4 of 2011 concerning Management of Culture-Based Education. But the socialization and implementation has not been intensive and effective. For this reason, the Java Language Study Program took the initiative to help implement the Cultural Based Education program. The target activity was 34 MGMP Javanese high school / vocational / MA teachers in Bantul Regency. The activity was held at Kasihan Bantul Public High School 1. Form of speeches and workshops. The speech was delivered by 5 speakers from UNY Javanese Language Education. Workshop by making plans for developing or implementing Culture-Based Education in schools. The results are (1) the teacher makes a plan for implementing Culture-Based Education in Javanese (cultural thought) subjects, (2) makes a plan for developing a Javanese cultural climate in schools, for example by implementing a culture of recitation and showing something with a thumb (act culture), school bell with gamelan, and implementation of Javanese fashion (material culture). Follow-up as a measure of success (1) one of the speakers was asked to continue the PPM activity with implementation assistance and (2) one of the members was asked to make a bell using gamelan instruments.
