ABSTRACT

This research aims at investigating the parent's role and parenting models in the tourism village of Sosromenduran Gedongtengen in developing the characters of tolerance and environmental care. In order to get a description of the parent's role and parenting models in the tourism village of Sosromenduran Gedongtengen in developing the characters of tolerance and environmental care, the research utilized a qualitative-naturalistic approach. The location of the research is in the tourism village of Sosromenduran Gedongtengen. The data collection techniques employed in this research include observations, interviews, and documentations. The data were validated using a source triangulation. The data were analyzed using an interactive analysis of Miles and Huberman. The results show that the role of parents in developing the children's character of tolerance and environmental care include: 1) motivators; 2) supervisors and protectors of the child both physically and spiritually; 3) mentors that educate children with various knowledge; and 4) role models that care and develop the children. The development of tolerance and environmental care characters on children is carried out using the following strategies: 1) developing skills for performing mutual respect with others; 2), designing activities that stimulate the development of tolerance and environmental care character; 3) performing positive habits by habituating the children to do activities which are useful for the parents and others; and 4) being strict toward the child's character development of tolerance and environmental care. Parenting models in the tourism village of Sosromenduran Gedongtengen consist of: 1) authoritarian; 2) democratic; and 3) situational parenting.
