## TRAINING OF P3K PRINCIPLES (FIRST AID FOR ACCIDENTS) AND BASIC LIFE SUPPORT FOR KINDERGARTEN AND EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION PROGRAMS TEACHERS IN BANTUL

## **ABSTRACT**

The purpose of this devotional activity is to improve the skills of teachers and early childhood educator assistants related to First Aid and basic life support principles. Because, the high physical activity performed by children often leads to the consequences of accidents or injuries. Oftenly, the teachers or counselors of early childhood are faced with a condition when their students experience accidents or disruptions to sudden and unexpected physical conditions. As a result of the incident, first-aid needs to be done as early as possible, or even a basic life aid that can reduce and eliminate the risk of injury, disability or even death. Partnering with LPPM Yogyakarta State University, Teacher Working Group (KKG) PAUD Kecamatan Bantul through one of the devotees team held training on 23 and 24 September 2017. Implementation of the training was conducted by lecture method and discussion on theory sessions, and group practice. In addition to the PPM team, it also involves an expert on early child development. It was ffollowed by 41 people from 9 institutions in Bantul. Before and after the training, participants are required to complete a material evaluation sheet (pre-posttest) using a questionnaire and evaluation of the implementation as a form of customer satisfaction.

Based on the value obtained from the questionnaire, the average score of pre-test results of participants is 74, which means in sufficient category, while the average-score of post-test results 81 or in either category. It Shows an increase in participants' knowledge of the principles of first aid and basic life support. Based on skill assessment with observation, after training, participants were able to provide first aid to burns, scratched, blisters, fainting, nosebleed, and bone fracture.
