ABSTRACT

This study aims to analyze the desacralization of the shift in the function of Dalem Joyokusuman's space, from its original function as a residence to a commercial space.

This type of qualitative research with descriptive method. Data was collected by means of literature study, interviews, observation, and scrutiny of document sources. The data findings were analyzed critically to find research conclusions. The results showed that there was a reform of the spatial system, the application of modern circulation patterns, there was no clear boundary between business and domestic activities (not applying the spatial quadrant pattern), no longer considering natural vegetation, and the absence of a central senthong which is the mundi axis or central point. holy from Dalem . There has been no change in the main physical structure of the building, so that the classic feel of the royal house of the Yogyakarta Palace is still felt from its interior and architectural elements, and this is what attracts visitors to come to visit because here the menu of the Yogyakarta Palace family is also served.
