

CLASSROOM ACTION RESEARCH (CAR) TRAINING TO IMPROVING LEARNING QUALITY FOR TEACHERS IN GROBOGAN

ABSTRACT

This Community Service Program (CSP) aims to: improve the quality of classroom learning by providing Classroom Action Research (PTK) for teachers in Grobogan District especially in Ngaringan and surrounding areas. The target of this activity is 25 potential teachers to be given CAR training.

The training was held at Sekolah Dasar Negeri (elementary school) 2 Kalangdosari for one day. The methods applied are lectures, frequently asked questions, discussions, and structured practices. The material presented in this training is the basic concept of CAR, the steps of preparing the CAR, and the practice of preparing the CAR proposal.

The results of the training include the increasing understanding of elementary school teachers in the region regarding the concept and steps of the CAR and its relationship to the teaching profession. The ability of teachers to recognize and analyze student learning problems that occur in the classroom also increases through this training. Abilities that have not been fully mastered by the teacher during the course of the training are to make the CAR proposal intact. From the results of the evaluation of the implementation of CSP activities, participants have high motivation and enthusiasm in training. One of the keys to the success of this CSP is the material that is required by the target or subject of training. In general, the activities run smoothly and reach the target both in quantity and quality.
