

Special Program Learning Differentiation Workshop in Implementing the Independent Curriculum at SLB PGRI Minggir Sleman

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ABSTRACT

Special needs programs in the area of external education are known as compensatory services which are educational practices specifically designed to overcome or prevent educational deficits and affect different population subgroups such as children with mental retardation, sensory disabilities, and behavioral disorders. Compensatory services also place a strong emphasis on increasing instructional time in basic skills areas (reading, language, mathematics). The provision of special program learning differentiation by teachers at SLB PGRI Minggir Sleman still requires more understanding because special program learning is a study of daily living activities or what is usually called a functional curriculum. One effort to support teachers in implementing the independent curriculum in SLB is by providing workshops as a form of support in increasing knowledge to overcome the difficulties faced in implementing the independent curriculum. Lecturer program activities outside campus are carried out through methods in the form of lectures, discussions and assistance in creating special program learning differentiation in the implementation of the Merdeka curriculum.
