TRAINING FOR THE PREPARATION OF JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL TEACHING MATERIALS IN THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC FOR DISTRICT JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS KEBUMEN CENTRAL JAVA

ABSTRACT

Social Science Learning during the Covid-19 pandemic experienced several problems, one of which was the lack of availability of digital teaching materials. This service aims to; 1) develop teacher competence in preparing teaching materials in the form of modules during the pandemic, 2) produce teaching materials in the form of modules during the pandemic for social studies subjects.

The training will be held online in July 2021, with 30 teachers from Kebumen, Central Java participating. At the initial stage, there was an equalization of perceptions and FGD of the service team with the MGMP management, continued with the preparation of teaching materials, and the implementation of training. The training is carried out online using zoom meeting media with lecture methods, questions and answers, workshops, and mentoring.

The results of the training are: 1) as many as 30 teachers graduated in the implementation of the training, so that they have increased abilities in developing distance learning modules for social studies subjects. 2) A total of 30 themes of distance learning social studies modules for grades VII, VIII, and IX were produced by the participants. The module was then returned to the Kebumen District MGMP for further development.
