ABSTRACT

This community service activity (PPM) aims to provide reinforcement in self-development so that alumni of the Department of Public Administration become more confident in facing the world of work and career while providing input for the development of the Department of Public Administration to improve the quality of learning in accordance with the demands of the world of work . The PPM activity is held for two days, namely 11 and 12 August 2018, taking place in the Lafran Pane Room of the FIS UNY. The target audience is the alumni of the State Administration of Social Sciences FIS, both those who have worked and those who have not. The target audience is 35 people. In its implementation, this activity involved the management of KAMNIGARA, which was an extension of the Alumni Family of State Administration and lecturer at JIAN FIS UNY. The method of this activity includes lectures, information discussions, workshops, and reflections. The evaluation of PPM activities included evaluating the abilities and skills of the participants in preparing the Self Development quadrant.
