

TRAINING OF SMOKED SALTED EGGS AS A FAMILY INCOME IMPROVEMENT

ABSTRACT

Community Service Programme (PPM) to Darma Wanita member of RT 01, RW. 01, Denokan, Maguwoharjo, Sleman, Yogyakarta. A total of 15 members from three Dasa Wisma groups (Mawar, Melati, and Nusa Indah) have been trained in the production of smoked salted eggs.

Implementation of PPM includes 3 stages were socialization, training, monitoring-evaluation. The socialization was held on July 29, 2017. The training phase for the production of smoked salted eggs on August 2 and 12, 2017. While monitoring the evaluation on August 19, 2017.

The result of the training of smoke salted egg production to the members of Dasa Wisma Mawar, Melati, and Nusa Indah was already in good category, with the outer layer of the yolk circle becoming oily. The fuming process takes place both marked by the prevalence of fumigation and no eggs being ruptured due to over fumigation. The training activities were benefited by the mothers who were involved in the training both in addition to the family's nutritional intake, as well as the utilization of valuable leisure time economically.
