Assistance in the Management Program Formulation Policy Inclusive Education in the Disability Service Unit of the Yogyakarta City Education Office

ABSTRACT

The PPM activity is in the form of a focus group workshop discussion by Yogyakarta City policy makers coordinated by the Education Office in an effort to establish a disability service institution (ULD). PPM aims to assist ULD in formulating policies, in the form of understanding insights about inclusion education for disability, arranging ULD institutional structures along with their duties and functions, testing the feasibility of policies from the relevant dinas, making articles as an effort to disseminate the results of PPM.

The results of the PPM show that: 1) most participants were the first to discuss ABK, characteristics and inclusive education, it was assumed that activities had an understanding in sufficient and conscious categories to build disability service commitments, 2) ULD policy to consolidate institutions, in the form of vision, mission ,aim. It also forms a simple and flexible structure to make it easier to decide on forms of service and partner with relevant institutions and experts in the implementation, 3) ULD policy feasibility tests conducted in an effort to capture commitments from related elements, non-education agencies, BAPEDA, Babinsa from the Police, Koramil, community organizations in inclusive education services for persons with disabilities. Another result of this PPM is in the form of PPM journal articles to produce results. The existence of supporting factors in the form of commitment of all institutional elements involved to build inclusive education through institutional programs according to their duties and functions and the role of ULD as a disability service coordination agency, as an indication of achieving PPM activities.
