COUNSELING ABOUT HAZARD AWARENESS OF TEXTILE DYES FOR FOOD FOR HOUSEWIFE IN SLEMAN

ABSTRACT

Dye is a food additive that can improve or give color to food. The type of dye that allowed for the food set out in Annex I, Minister of Health of RI No.033 in 2012 and prohibited materials used as BTP set out in Annex 2. extile dye is a dye which is banned as BTP, but many prepared foods using this dye. Cases of abuse of textile dyes is increasing rapidly. Abuse happens because users do not understand the nature of the chemical, physical, dangers to health, and regulations. This condition is very alarming. Therefore it is necessary for couseling activities. Counseling activities aim to provide 1) knowledge about the dangers of misuse of textile dyes in food and 2) understanding the importance of using the dye properly and safely. Counseling activities carried out in the rectory hall Klepu, Sendangmulyo, Minggir, Sleman, DIY, on the day Mnggu, September 4, 2016. This event was attended by 39 housewives who live in the western part of Sleman. Material activities include: synthetic dyes are banned for food (AK. Prodjosantoso), Health Minister Regulation No. 033 of 2012 on BTB (M. Pranjoto Utomo), textile dyes (Regina Tutik P), and dyes which allowed for food (Karim Theresih). This service activities to increase knowledge and experience for housewives in choosing dyes that are safe for health.
