Special education learning management training for teachers during school from home (SCH) by Pujaningsih, Rochmat Wahab, Mumpuniarti, Nurdayati Praptiningrum, Bayu Pamungkas

ABSTRACT

The public services entitled learning management training for teachers with special needs during School From Home (SCH) was conducted in two activities, namely: online webinars on June 10, 2020 and online workshops on August 25, 2020. The targets of online webinars are teachers, lecturers, parents and observers of special needs education with a total of 1005 participants. Meanwhile, the online workshop specifically focused on providing support for learning during the pandemic era for 21 teachers in one of the special schools in Yogyakarta.

The results of the webinar activity can be identified that there are differences in the webinar participants' knowledge of special education instruction who took the pre-test and post-test as many as 400 people regarding learning strategies for children with special needs, t (400) = 0.029. Workshop activities were conducted online based needs assessments. There were needs in the area mapping students' initial abilities, mapping home support in online learning, flexibility in implementing online learning, strategies to increase student motivation, and teacher time management.
