

Employability skills of individual with disabilities: Employers perspectives

ABSTRACT

Postschool outcomes of students with disabilities regarding employment are remain poor compare to students with non-disabilities. Approximately 74 % of individual with disabilities in Indonesia are unemployed. This research examine employability skills of individual with disabilities from employers perspectives. This is a systematic reviewed involving articles from three leading journal publisher that are Sage, Proquest, and EBSCO. Eligibility criteria are scholarly article published between 2010-2020 that are investigated employability skills from employers perspective. There is no limitation in terms of disability type investigated in this research. Nine studies were included in the review. They covered both quality of hard skills and soft skills needed for successful employment.
