TRAINING TO DEVELOP PRESCHOOL TEACHERS' CREATIVITY THROUGH CHILDREN'S ART AND TEXTILE CRAFTS LEARNING (SHIBORI & JUMPUTAN)

ABSTRACT

This community service aims to increase the creativity of PAUD teachers in using a variety of fun media in teaching children, increasing children's creativity and fine motor skills with media that is easily available around them. The target audience for this research is kindergarten teachers in Depok sub-district. The method that will be applied in this activity is training and direct practice. In this training, several activities will be provided which include the presentation of material and the practice of making crafts from newspaper waste by service providers followed by training participants consisting of Kindergarten Teachers. The workshop was carried out using presentation, discussion and joint practice methods. The resonance method is used to convey the stages and steps in work practice (technical skills) which are conveyed by the service team which is followed by workshop participants. Participants follow the printing process by the team and are then tasked with making it directly. The participants' work processes are individual and carried out according to their respective aesthetic expressions. It is hoped that the results of this program will increase participants' insight regarding the idea of a more meaningful basic arts and crafts learning process for children and can then continue to develop it in fun learning inside and outside the classroom.
