COMMUNITY-BASED DISASTER MITIGATION IN PULESARI TOURISM VILLAGE, WONOKERTO, TURI DISTRICT, SLEMAN REGENCY, YOGYAKARTA

ABSTRACT

Community-based disaster mitigation in the tourist village of Pulesari Wonokerto, Turi Sleman District, Yogyakarta, is carried out through assistance and training so that the community receives education in dealing with disasters. Its regional characteristics are on the slopes of Mount Merapi which is vulnerable to disasters, namely Mount Erupus. Tourism villages are one of the sectors to improve the economy and community welfare, so with this potential vulnerability, community knowledge and skills are needed to be able to manage tourism. This assistance and training is carried out by the community as well as village officials involved through focus group discussion, question and answer and simulation methods in disaster mitigation. Please note that disaster mitigation includes before, during and after a disaster occurs. The knowledge and skills that the community must have are carried out using various media, including digital technology in the form of video, PowerPoint and ecomedia as media to facilitate understanding of disaster mitigation. This activity is carried out with preparation through needs analysis, implementation of activities and evaluation at the end which covers the whole so that it can be seen how effective the training and assistance is for disaster mitigation in tourism villages so that they can recommend and decide on the latest policies for managing tourism villages based on disaster preparedness villages. Environmental conservation activities carried out are in the form of focus group discussions through workshops with residents regarding environmental preservation in the tourist village. Soil conservation is done by maintaining groundwater and selecting plants that are capable of providing economic benefits. The second activity was also carried out by looking at education regarding economic plants to improve the economy of local residents and provide encouragement for tourism in the village
