ASSESSMENT OF LEARNING TECHNIQUE TRAINING FOR IPS TEACHERS IN BANJARNEGARA

ABSTRACT

Assessment is an important part of the learning process. Educators as managers of learning activities in carrying out assessments can find out the abilities possessed by students, the accuracy of the teaching methods used, and the success of students in achieving the competencies that have been set. Based on the results of the assessment, educators can make appropriate decisions to determine what steps to take next. The results of the assessment can also motivate students to perform better. Various types of valuation techniques can be done complementary (complementary) in accordance with the competencies assessed.
