ABSTRACT

Diagnostic assessment determines students' weaknesses in mastering particular material or competencies and their causes. The results of the diagnostic evaluation can be used as a basis for providing follow-up in the form of appropriate treatment (intervention) that is appropriate to the student's weaknesses. This mentoring activity aims to increase teachers' understanding and skills in diagnostic assessments and di@erentiated learning based on the independent curriculum in elementary schools in the Yogyakarta City area. Activities are carried out in guided workshops and intensive mentoring by a team of lecturers in the fields of Language, Social Sciences, Mathematics, and Counseling Guidance. The result of this program is the formation of a teaching module equipped with an assessment based on the diagnostics of elementary school students in the Yogyakarta City environment.
