The Impact of International Accreditation on Study Program Performance at UNY

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ABSTRACT

Yogyakarta State University, as one of the tertiary institutions in Indonesia, has also included several study programs in the international accreditation program. In 2023, there will be 48 study programs that have been internationally accredited, with details of 26 ASIC accredited study programs, 4 AQAS accredited study programs, 13 ASIIN accredited study programs, and 5 FIBAA accredited study programs. Apart from the international accreditation above, UNY also has four study programs that are AUN-QA certified. However, there has been no evaluation of the impact of this accreditation. This research aims to explore the impact of international accreditation on students, lecturers, and study program managers.

This research is exploratory descriptive research. The subjects of this research are students, lecturers, and study program managers from internationally accredited study programs, while the object is study program performance. The population in this research is all students, lecturers, and study program managers at Yogyakarta State University, which has been internationally accredited, totaling 37 study programs spread across 7 faculties. The instruments of this research are questionnaires and documents. The questionnaire contains a series of questions and open-ended questions. All study programs at Yogyakarta State University that have international accreditation were sent questionnaires, which were addressed to three research subjects. The contents of the questionnaire ask about the performance of the study program before and after being internationally accredited. The documents used as instruments in this research are those related to study program performance data such as number of students and lecturers, interest, study period, GPA (Cumulative Performance Index), and waiting period for graduates. The results of this study show the diversity of responses from students, lecturers and study program managers regarding the effects of international accreditation of study programs
