## VHS's Teacher's Strategy in Implementing Online Learning during the Covid-19 Pandemic by Sutirman, Muslikhah Dwihartanti, Isti Kistiananingsih, Acha Wahyu Hidayah Sri Muhimatul Laila

## **ABSTRACT**

The learning process at all levels of education has changed to distance/online learning due to the Covid-19 pandemic. The sudden implementation of distance/online learning policies resulted in many obstacles and obstacles during the implementation process. The purpose of this study was to find out 1) the strategies applied by OTKP SMK teachers in carrying out online learning during the Covid-19 pandemic, 2) the obstacles faced by OTKP SMK teachers in carrying out learning during the COVID-19 pandemic, 3) OTKP Vocational High School students' learning outcomes. during the covid-19 pandemic. This study used an ex post facto design with a descriptive method. The population in this study consisted of teachers of SMK OTKP in Central Java, the sample was selected using a random sampling area technique with 2 teachers from each Vocational School. The data collection technique used a survey method with a questionnaire instrument and a list of documents. The questionnaire was prepared using a graded scale with 5 answer choices. The answer categories on the questionnaire consisted of: always (SL), often (SR), sometimes (KD), rarely (JR) and never (TP). Data analysis used descriptive qualitative and quantitative. The results showed that 1) The implementation of the learning strategies of OTKP SMK teachers in Central Java had been implemented well. 2) Barriers experienced by OTKP SMK teachers in Central Java in implementing distance learning are devices, students, materials and teacher motivation. 3) The learning outcomes of OTKP Vocational High School students in Central Java after implementing distance learning are 92.96% for the knowledge aspect and 91.55% for the skills aspectmethods with questionnaire and documentation technique. The data collection instruments to be used are questionnaires and documentation.
