COACHING CLINIC FUTSAL FOR TEACHERS OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION IN WONOGIRI DISTRICT

ABSTRACT

Futsal is a sport that is popular and is popular throughout the world, both among adults and adolescents. It is not uncommon for many adults to spend the weekend playing futsal, because futsal has its own charm for those who play big ball sports. Futsal is considered to be able to create an atmosphere of togetherness between individuals in a team and the course of play tends to be fast because of the smaller field rules of football. The aim of general service activities is to conduct a Futsal Coaching Clinic for Elementary School Physical Education Teachers in Wonogiri Regency. The specific objectives of the Coaching Clinic activities are: (1) Increasing the ability and awareness of Physical Education Working Group (KKG) members in participating in training / sports to improve pedagogical competence, (2) Increasing knowledge and understanding of the importance of increasing teaching abilities especially on Futsal Material, (3) Increasing the knowledge and understanding of Physical Education Working Group (KKG) members in compiling, implementing, and evaluating learning programs for Elementary School Physical Education (SD) especially Futsal material.

The process of Futsal Coaching Clinic to be able to take place according to the target needs to be implemented several methods, including: (1) Lecture and discussion methods (2) Demonstration methods, and (3) Practice methods, namely practicing Futsal training and learning models by Working Group participants The Physical Education Teachers (KKG) are guided by presenters from the service team.

The results of this activity are as follows: (1) Futsal Coaching Clinic activities for Primary School Physical Education Teachers in Wonogiri Regency took place smoothly without experiencing significant obstacles, (2) most (85%) participants were able to understand and were very enthusiastic and looks able to implement properly and correctly, and (3) There are requests from participants and administrators of the Penjas Teacher Working Group (KKG) in Wonogiri Regency to hold further technical guidance activities. As suggestions during the activity, they include: (1) PPM activities are followed up with the holding of joint training activities, (2) PPM activities are followed up with joint Futsal competition activities between elementary schools, (3) there is a need for greater joint activities involving the Forum Another Penjas KKG in Wonogiri Regency.
