ABSTRACT

This program focuses on improving the competency of BKL cadre who always interact directly with the elderly. This competency increase is carried out through participatory social welfare services training for elderly cadres. The target audience in this program is BKL Mugi Waras' cadre, Moyudan, Sleman, D.I. Yogyakarta. This program activity is conducted through training and focus group discussion (FGD).

The implementation program has been able to increase the competence of BKL Mugi Waras cadres through participatory social welfare training for the elderly.
