

Improving the Ability of Teachers of Vocational High School OTKP Central Java in Making Media PowerPoint Learning by Voice

ABSTRACT

Most vocational high schools (VHS) teachers have limited time to develop instructional media independently while the instructional media is one of the important parts of distance learning and it must be met. One of the solutions offered by the devotional team is to facilitate VHS teachers, especially OTKP in Central Java in developing PowerPoint -based learning media with voice. The form of activities that will be held is an online workshop. The method of carrying out activities in this devotional is lectures, demonstrations, discussion and evaluations. Based on the results of the evaluation of the implementation of community service activities, the following results are obtained 1) the average participation level of participants is 58 people or 193.3% of the target that has been set, 2) the average number of participants who passed the posttest 51 people or 204% of the target determined, 3) the average percentage of participants who gave an interesting response to the material was 98.47% 4) The number of learning media with good and very good categories as many as 22 people or 73%. 5) participants' assessments of devotional activities, speakers, committees and facilities were in the excellent category
