Entrepreneurship Training of Catfish Cultivation by Using Tarpaulins to Foster Children of Bina Insan Mandiri, Yogyakarta

ABSTRACT

Abstract There are many young people who have become unemployement because of limitation of job opportunities and belief that being a civil servant is the most high status in working. Therefore, community service activity which is formed in entrepreneurship education was held by Nonformal Department personel, from Yogyakarta State University, to give young people who be foster children of Bina Insan Mandiri as social empowerment institution, located in Yogyakarta. The activity done to give knowledge and skills to cultivate catfish by using tarpaulins media so that it could be meaningful to their live. The media is concidered cheaper and don't need a large place. Implementation of the activity used teaching method which focused on experiential approach by which learner directly manage catfish cultivation. Before, the trainer tought them how to practice it in class by using discussion and interview method. The trainer choosen becouse he is practitioner who have a lot of experience. This training held on two day located in the institution. Result of the training considered very success. It could be seen by some indicators namely first, as many as 30 people was present who were previously planned only 25 people; second, substance that was delivered felt beneficial by the learner because it was based on need assesment that was done before and good prospect of the cultivation system; third, there are increasing their understanding that could be found in learning interaction, in which they were more enthusiastic asking to the trainer. It means they have curiosity to have entrepreneurship capability on fishery, and the last, they also have knowledge how to doing the post-harvest marketing.
