Text book "AJAR BASA JAVA" class IV, V, and VI readability based on BSNP parameters and fry test by Prof. Dr. Suwarna, M.Pd.; Nurhidayati, M. Hum.; Sri Hertanti Wulan, M. Hum.; Yayan Rubiyanto, M. Pd.

## **ABSTRACT**

Assessment of the quality of textbooks is important to study in order to measure their suitability with the needs of students and alignment with the curriculum. The Textbook "Teaching Javanese (ABJ)" is a Javanese language subject book used for elementary school students in DIY. This research is a multi-year study with the object of studying ABJ books for grades 4, 5 and 6 elementary schools.

The research method in this study is descriptive research. The research instruments consisted of (1) the readability quality of the Fry Chart legibility parameter and (2) the legibility parameter instrument from the BSNP. The BSNP parameter book quality instrument consists of the feasibility of (a) content, (b) language, (c) presentation, and (d) graphics. The validity of the data was obtained by validating the techniques of persistence and accuracy of observation, repeated review, and peer checking. Qualitative analysis with BSNP and quantitative parameters based on Fry Charts.

The results are (1) based on Fry's Graphic analysis, ABJ grade 4 elementary school books do not meet the legibility of grade 4 books (more suitable for grade 7). This is caused by (a) words with 3-4 syllables, (b) difficult words, (c) typos/inaccuracy of the authors, (d) ambiguous words, and (e) sentences that are too long. Meanwhile, in terms of the BSNP assessment indicators in terms of appropriate content, inadequate language, poor presentation, and decent graphics. (2) Based on the Class 5 ABJ Fry Chart, it was stated that it did not yet have proper legibility. This is mainly caused by sentences that are too long and compound sentences. The book is suggested to be revised in terms of (1) it is better to use single sentences, not complex sentences, (2) not long sentences, (3) use diction according to the level of cognitive development of grade 5 elementary school students. (3) Based on the Fry ABJ Graph class 6 SD already meets legibility. This is caused by ) (a) simple sentence patterns, (b) sentences that are only a few long (c) many syllables with 2-3 syllables, (d) minimal use of compound words. In terms of BSNP grade 6 books are in the good category.
