The Effectiveness of Thesis Guidance Model for the Students of FBS UNY using Guided Writing

ABSTRACT

The objective of this second year research is to develop a model of guided thesis writing as counseling techniques for students. The development of this model is motivated by the length of the completion of the final project experienced by most students majoring in French Language Education is currently preparing a thesis.
